## PRESS RELEASE

Ackermans & van Haaren (via its subsidiary Sofinim) and ImmoBEL have sold their respective 37,5% stakes in I.D.I.M., in which the Regional Development Corporation Brussels (R.D.C.B.) and Regional Investment in Brussels (S.R.I.B.) were already associated for a total of 10.6 million euros to the R.D.C.B.

I.D.I.M. s.a. owns a plot of 4.7 ha in Neder-over-Heembeek (Brussels City) ideally located between the North ringroad and the sites developed by the R.D.C.B. (Galilei and Mercator), as well as a property located in the Da Vinci Park at the intersection of Haren (Brussels-City) and Evere.

The site in Neder-over-Heembeek will be equipped to accommodate companies looking for space there. The R.D.C.B. responded in 2007 and 2008 in the frame of its missions positively to the investigations of 96 companies generating a Brussels anchor for nearly 3800 jobs.

The R.D.C.B., the S.R.I.B., Sofinim and ImmoBEL, all associated with I.D.I.M. for many years, welcomed the agreement allowing the private partners to focus on the development of many projects in their portfolio, and the two major public actors of the Brussels economy R.D.C.B. and S.R.I.B. to have at their disposal the land required to contribute to economic expansion in the region.

The company is now called the Brussels Agency for the Development of Real Estate (B.A.D.R.).

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
